E: Outreach Activities: Brief Descriptions of Activities Performed in the Last Year

I. Menu Item #5: Internship Program (Supplemental Recruitment Forms included in Appendix 2a)

Located near the campus of Kansas State University, in Manhattan Kansas, Manhattan Broadcasting Company offers selected internships for those interested in broadcasting. The internship is designed to offer interested parties "hands on" experience with specific responsibilities in the areas of broadcasting in which they have an interest. Examples of internships in being offered include: Sales and Marketing, News, Sports, Promotions, Digital, and On-Air Production. MBC also works in conjunction with Kansas State University for Students to also obtain college credit by enrolling in the K-State internship program offered by the A.Q. Miller School of Journalism. The hours may very predicated on the number of credit hours the student intends to earn. All internships are on a credit or monetary basis, which is determined by Manhattan Broadcasting prior to the internship commencing.

II. Menu Item #10: Participation in at least four events or programs sponsored by educational institutions relating to careers opportunities in broadcasting

Manhattan Broadcasting Company, for many years, has offered a program sponsored by educational institutions for students exploring careers in broadcasting. The program gives high school and or college students the opportunity to observe radio station personnel in their actual work environment. Students have the opportunity to select which radio station at MBC they wish to observe station staff on the job. The program is coordinated with educational institutions within Manhattan Broadcasting's coverage area to give students a snapshot view of their particular area of interest as well as overall station operation. This program is offered at the beginning of fall, spring, and summer classes. Manhattan Broadcasting also offers guided tours to groups, organizations, and others with an interest in broadcasting. The Manhattan Broadcasting management and staff also speak to area schools and civic organizations on broadcast operations, service, and careers.

III. Menu Item #2: Hosting Job Fairs (Supplemental Recruitment Forms included in Appendix 2c)

Manhattan Broadcasting Company hosts a job and recruitment fair in which station management are present to discuss careers in broadcasting. During the event Manhattan Broadcasting provides Fact Sheets describing the various job roles and opportunities available at Manhattan Broadcasting. Specific descriptions include Marketing Consultant, Sales Assistant, News Director, Program Director, Traffic Director, Production Director, Programming, Digital Marketing, Sales Manager, and On-Air Talent. Those in attendance have the opportunity to meet with station management to discuss their specific job interests as well as inquire about any currently available job positions and upcoming internship opportunities. During the year, Manhattan Broadcasting also participates in job fairs and employment events held by the A.Q. Miller School of Broadcasting at Kansas State University, as well as the student job events held by the Kansas Association of Broadcasters. During those job fairs and employment events, Manhattan Broadcasting management personnel are in attendance to answer question for those attending the job fair.
